- ✓ Stall fees - \$3 per foot prior to June 1<sup>st</sup> \$5 per foot from June 2<sup>nd</sup> to June 16<sup>th</sup> (all tack and supplies must be contained within allotted stall space)
- ✓ Entry fees \$15 for 1<sup>st</sup> animal and \$10 per additional animal prior to June 1<sup>st</sup> or \$25 for 1<sup>st</sup> animal and \$20 per additional animal from June 2<sup>nd</sup> to June 16<sup>th</sup>
- ✓ Peewee entry fees \$10 for 1<sup>st</sup> animal and \$5 per additional animal prior to June 1<sup>st</sup> or \$15 for 1<sup>st</sup> animal and \$10 per additional animal from June 2<sup>nd</sup> to June 16<sup>th</sup>
- ✓ Judging, Grooming and Showmanship competitions \$5.00 per competition per participant

**Rules and Guidelines:**

1. **Entry Fee - Stall Fee** - \$ 3 per foot up to June 1<sup>st</sup>, \$ 5 per foot from June 2<sup>nd</sup> to June 15<sup>th</sup>.  
Plus;
  - a) **Junior** entry fees of \$ 15 for 1<sup>st</sup> Animal and \$ 10 per additional animal prior to June 1<sup>st</sup>, or; \$ 25 for 1<sup>st</sup> Animal and \$ 20 per additional animal from June 2<sup>nd</sup> to June 15<sup>th</sup>.
  - b) **Peewee** entry fees of \$ 10 for 1<sup>st</sup> Animal and \$ 5 per additional animal prior to June 1<sup>st</sup>, or; \$ 15 for 1<sup>st</sup> Animal and \$ 10 per additional animal from June 2<sup>nd</sup> to June 15<sup>th</sup>.
2. Show is open to Junior's (Age 6 - 21 as of December 31, 2017).
3. Animals entered in the Peewee (Classes 100,200,500) are shown in these classes and do not compete against juniors.
4. Copy of the Registration papers must accompany entry for all purebred entries.
5. Tattoos must be legible.
6. The Show Committee and or its members are not responsible for accident or loss.
7. The show committee will have the ability to increase or decrease the length of the show as required to accommodate entry's received.
8. Livestock competing in competitions must be in the barns by 8:00 a.m. Saturday, June 24, 2017.
9. Livestock competing in conformation class on Sunday only and not participating in competition events must be in the Barn and ready to show by 8:00 am on Sunday.
10. All grooming, clipping, preparation and showing of animals must be done by the junior. In the case of young members (Peewee), older members will be requested to assist.  
**Adult/Parent participation is forbidden.**
11. All cattle must have a CCIA tag in their ear before arriving on the grounds. Any animal without CCIA tag will be disqualified, and asked to leave.
12. The use of steroids or any other means to enhance the growth or conformation of animals is strictly forbidden and will result in disqualification.
13. Unethical fitting of animals is FORBIDDEN and will result in disqualification.
14. Substitute entries will be permitted provided that they are within the same class.

Note: Any decisions made by the show committee will be final (disputes etc.)

**Class Descriptions:**

Peewee calves: for these classes (100 & 500) the animal must be a calf born in the 2017 calendar year.

Peewee yearling heifer class: for this class (200) the animal must be a tame halter broke heifer that the Peewee can handle with ease and little to no assistance.

Purebred all breed: in the class the junior may show any purebred, registered animal.

Commercial: in this class the junior may show any commercial animal.

Feature Breed: This class will be made available for any junior breed association requesting and entering a minimum of 30 class entries.

**Confirmation Class Rules**

**Peewee**

1. The junior in these classes may only show in these classes.
2. Only calendar calves may be shown in the Calendar Calf Class.
3. If you have a tame yearling heifer you may show it in the Peewee yearling heifer class.
4. Participants may have assistance from older juniors, but adult/parent assistance is strictly forbidden.
5. Participants in these classes may show any animals available to them.

**Purebred**

1. Purebred animal which must be registered with respective breed association.
2. Animals must be tattooed
3. Please have a photocopy of papers ready on request.
4. Animal must be calm and manageable by Junior.

**Commercial**

1. Commercial animal.
2. Animal must be calm and manageable by Junior.

The decision of the Barn Boss/Directors shall be final. Any violation of rules may result in disqualification or a worse penalty.

Please keep the environment safe and positive for ALL participants and spectators.
